Duvet, pillow, mattress pad and pillow protector made of 100% cotton woven fabric in white, piece-dyed or pigment printed, or polyester/cotton or TENCEL®/cotton woven fabric, raw white; or 100% PES knitted or non-woven fabric, PESlyocell knitted fabric, PES woven fabric, all in raw or bleached white; or tri-dimensional knitted fabric (including 3D mesh fabric) made of PES, ultrahigh molecular polyethylene, cotton, linen, viscose, viscose from bamboo fiber, TENCEL®, polyamide, PESmetallic yarn, bamboo charcoal yarn knitted fabric as shell fabric, in colour white or natural colour; PES fiber as interlining; PES yarn knitted fabric as backing, white, dyed and finished; all compounded with TPU, PEVA or PE film; including accessories (white duck or goose down and feather, or raw polyester staple fibre, with or without transparent glass beads, white or dyed PES sewing thread, polyamide/nylon zipper, white PES non-woven fabric and white polyethylene label printed with black ink)

The results of the inspection made according to STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX®, Annex 4, product class II have shown that the above mentioned goods meet the human-ecological requirements of the STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX® presently established in Annex 4 for products with direct contact to skin.

The certified articles fulfil requirements of Annex XVII of REACH (incl. the use of azo colourants, nickel release, etc.), the American requirement regarding total content of lead in children's articles (CPSIA, with the exception of accessories made from glass) and of the Chinese standard GB 18401:2010 (labelling requirements were not verified).

The holder of the certificate, who has issued a conformity declaration according to ISO 17050-1, is under an obligation to use STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX® mark only in conjunction with products that conform with the sample initially tested. The conformity is verified by audits.
